OUTFOXED

Released last summer, the documentary *Outfoxed* examines how media empires, led by Rupert Murdoch's Fox News, have been running what many see as a "race to the bottom" in television news. This film provides an in-depth look at Fox News and the impact on society when a broad swath of media is controlled by one person.
